Description: Student council is a student government organization that sponsors events for the entire student body. Meetings are spent preparing and organizing details for these events. Student council also takes suggestions from the student body and tries to make improvements in the school atmosphere.

Meetings (time, place, and duration): Meetings are held every Tuesday morning at 7 am in Lecture Room B. Meetings last approximately 35 minutes.

Requirements for membership: Members fill out and submit applications. The best applications are chosen by the executive board. The applicants name is kept anonymous during the selection process. Applications are available in the spring for the upcoming school year. Freshmen will have the opportunity to get an application at Freshman Orientation or at the beginning of each school year. Class officers, once elected, are automatically members and do not need to fill out an application.
